The KYC Foundation has been working hard over the winter to organize and get ready for the 2024 sailing season. We have two offerings for adult and family sailing lessons over the summer. **Visit** <u>SailKenosha.org</u> to register for either program.

We have our First Sail Experience, which is a US Sailing program, offering the public access to their 'first sail'.

After the students First Sail, they can continue with instruction by taking our Sail 101. Or those with some exposure to sailing can jump right into the Sail 101.
