New Youth Waterfront Program offered by the Kenosha Community Sailing Center

Sunshine yellow, neon green and bright white are the colors of the Kenosha Community Sailing Center's watercraft. It's hard to miss the vessels when they are out sailing in the Kenosha harbor and that's just what the sailing center wants. They want everyone to notice that there are opportunities for families to get out and be on the water.

The center is in its third season renting watercraft and their 14th year teaching sailing in the harbor. They are a non-profit that does a lot more than teach sailing. The center promotes water safety, water conservation and does all they can to get people of all ages to appreciate the power and beauty of Lake Michigan.

This summer, KCSC has introduced a new 4-day Youth Waterfront Program where kids (ages 7-14) can enjoy the pedal duck boats, kayaking, paddleboarding and sailing. The program will also include games at the beach, arts & crafts, water safety and conservation. There are two sessions being offered July 5th thru July 8th and August 22 thru August 25. Registration can be done online at kenoshasailing.org and the cost is \$300 for the day long program.

Bettie Wescott, KCSC's Youth Education Director explains, "Our goal is to teach through fun and when water is involved, it's always fun, but we use every opportunity to get children to respect the lake. Having the pedal duck boats, kayaks and paddleboards is inviting to kids and families, but I can assure you that when you rent or participate in one of our programs or classes, you leave knowing how to properly wear a life jacket and are much more in tune with the weather and water."

"Situational Awareness" is a concept that is used frequently when the sailing center teaches sailing or being out on the water. Situational awareness is being aware of what is happening around you in terms of where you are, where you are supposed to be, and whether anyone or anything around you is a threat to your health and safety. It is important for both children and adults to develop this sense and sailing does that.

In addition to youth sailing classes, which are taught all summer long, the Kenosha Community Sailing Center offers adult, family, private and small group sailing classes. Many people have "learning how to sail" on their bucket list and other adults sailed as children and are looking to return to the helm. What is particularly nice about a community sailing center, is that those who want to learn to sail do not need to purchase a boat. Interested individuals are able to take courses and join a community of beginners and seasoned sailors.

Also new this year, the Kenosha Community Sailing Center is hosting what they call "Community Nights" on Thursday evenings where they are making their rental watercraft available to nonprofits especially those that serve families and youth. "There is a reason we are called a 'community' sailing center" explains Jim Buck, president and founder of the nonprofit. "Our goal is to get every kid down here at least once and let them experience a boat ride and learn a bit about water safety."
